



Naloxone Hero Annual Evaluation

The purpose of this annual evaluation is to ensure compliance with ARORP requirements; to confirm appropriate progress in the opioid abatement project approved by ARORP, city and county officials, the ARORP Advisory Board, administrators of the Qualified Settlement Fund (QSF), the Association of Arkansas Counties, and the Arkansas Municipal League; and to verify proper stewardship of opioid settlement dollars. Naloxone Hero projects are active for one year, and the evaluation will take place following the project's expiration date.
