| Continue treatment and recovery services   | September 30, Annually  | Yes               | Horizon Renewal Center received its first admissions, legal team, immediately providing services to individuals living with SUD and OUD. Since opening, Horizon Renewal Center has successfully graduated 10 individuals from the treatment program. Our diverse group of graduates includes those referred by DCF, the court system, federal probation, self-referrals, and our Crisis Stabilization Unit. This early success highlights the effectiveness of our tailored approach to treatment, demonstrating our commitment to supporting individuals from various backgrounds on their journey to recovery. Services rendered to individuals during their stay with us include group and individual counseling, peer support, case management, access to psychiatric care and medication management. Participants engage in a variety of other daily enrichment activities such as equine therapy, art therapy, yoga, and therapeutic outings to some of the most serene countryside in Arkansas. We look forward to continuing to empower more individuals to achieve and sustain remission from substance use disorder as we expand our impact in the community. 14 individuals were brought in for services during this time. |
