



Naloxone Community Hero Project Proposal

What is the Naloxone Community Hero Project?

In 2022, ARORP created the Arkansas Naloxone Bank to maintain a stockpile of naloxone that can be accessed by both community organizations and first responder agencies by applying to be a Naloxone Community Hero. Successful applicants will receive a credit for naloxone to distribute within their communities. The credit will allow them to obtain as much naloxone as they need for one year. These organizations/agencies host routine naloxone trainings, equipping every trainee with a free dose of naloxone. Organizations report to ARORP quarterly. Naloxone may also be used for discharge from hospitals, private mental health facilities, treatment facilities, recovery facilities, and county detention facilities.

How do I become a Naloxone Community Hero?

Fill out an application at www.arorp.com/funding-opportunities. Click on “Naloxone Community Hero Application, Apply Now.” Sign into a Google account. If you do not have a Google account, you must create one. View instructions under the “Help” tab. Once you sign into your Google account, you can view the proposal template and type into the document. We will not receive your application until it is finished and you click “Submit.” You do not need to hire a grant writer. There is no deadline for the Naloxone Community Hero proposal, so please take your time with your application.

What will I need to include in my proposal?

- The contact information of mayor(s) and county judge(s) in the jurisdiction you plan to serve
- The amount of requested naloxone
- A data-driven explanation of your community's need for the program
- A brief explanation of what you hope to accomplish

What will I be responsible for if I am selected?

- Distributing naloxone
- Providing training on naloxone use (Training provided by ARORP)
- Ensuring participants download the ReviveAR app
- Collecting simple data on trainings and distribution
- Submitting a quarterly report detailing your progress
