Of the 16 cases closed this quarter, 2 of them were closed after an arrest was made by the Investigator and assistance was provided to the victim and/or the victim's family by the Peer Support.

The remaining 14 cases were closed after all leads had been exhausted by the Investigator. Of those cases, assistance was provided by the Peer Support to the victim and/or the victim's family in 4 cases. Unfortunately, the Peer Support was unable to locate or reconnect with the victim and/or the victim's family after the initial overdose in 9 cases. In 1 isolated case, the victim refused any assistance from the Peer Support.

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Please briefly explain why cases were closed	There were 16 cases closed this quarter. Of those, 12 cases originated from this quarter while 4 cases carried over from the previous quarter. Of the 16 cases, 14 cases were closed after all leads had been exhausted by the investigator and multiple attempts of assistance was made by the peer support. Some of those attempts were successful while others were not. After investigation, 1 case was closed subsequent to an arrest. Finally, 1 case was closed after it was determined that the patient had inadvertently overdosed on prescribed medication. No evidence of illicit intent or illegal narcotics was found.
